

## Student Application Procedure

The following is the process for admission to Central Valley Christian Schools :

### **I. Criteria established for admission to CVC**

- A. Parents are expected to:
  - 1. Agree with and sign the Statement of Faith
  - 2. Regularly attend and participate in the life of a Bible believing and teaching Church.
  - 3. Give evidence of their positive relationship with Jesus Christ.
- B. Students are expected to:
  - 1. Give evidence of potential academic success in the school's program based on previous records and recommendations.
  - 2. Give evidence of good social adjustment and satisfactory behavior.

### **II. Steps for completing the Application and Admission Process**

- A. Return the application form with a \$100 matriculation fee.
- B. Complete and return the Statement of Faith.
- C. Present copies of report cards and standardized tests from the last two years.
- D. Distribute the appropriate forms to pastor and to the school the child is presently attending.
- E. After CVC has received the appropriate forms, an interview will be scheduled with the family. A final decision for acceptance and admission will be made by the CVC Board.

### **III. Interview with Families**

Following completion of the application, the family of each student will be interviewed by the principal and a board member. Students applying to enter grades 7-12 are expected to be present and participate in the interview.

During the interview parents will be asked about the following:

- A. Their Christian commitment through their relationship to Jesus.
- B. To explain their efforts to establish a Godly home.
- C. Clarify any questions regarding the student's application - academic, social, behavioral, spiritual, and physical.

CVC believes strongly that the education of a child involves three vital components: The home, the school, and the church. Our goal is to know that we will be working together to guide your child in a consistent direction through the home and church as well as through our efforts at Central Valley Christian School.
